The First Mystery of Salvation, the Nativity of our Lord.

Our Father...

- 1. For the Immaculate Conception, for the pure and chaste love of Mary. *Response: We thank you O Lord.* (Longer version: *Hail Mary...*)
- 2. For the Annunciation and Mary's consent to do the will of God. R
- 3. For the angel sent to assure Joseph of the Incarnation of Christ. R
- 4 For the Visitation, where the baby in Elizabeth's womb jumped for joy at the presence of Jesus in Mary. For the sanctity of life from conception to natural death. **R**
- 5. For the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ to Mary and Joseph, who laid him in the manger, as the Bread of Life. *Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory be...*
- 6. For the Epiphany of the Magi and the joy of the shepherds who came to worship the newborn king. R
- 7. For the Presentation of Jesus in the temple, dedicating his life to God. R
- 8. For the angel who warned Joseph in a dream to flee the persecution of Herod, for the Holy Innocent Martyrs. R
- 9. For the Holy Family's return to Israel to live an ordinary life in Nazareth. R
- 10. For the joy of finding Jesus in his Father's house, obeying the will of God. R

The Second Mystery of Salvation, the Proclamation of the Kingdom of God.

Our Father...

- 1. For transforming the baptism of repentance into the Sacrament of Baptism with the Holy Spirit. R: We praise you O Lord. (Longer version: Hail Mary...or Our Father...)
- 2. For your time in the desert teaching us how to resist temptation and overcome evil. R
- 3. For inviting us to become your disciples. For the sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Orders. R
- 4. For the Wedding at Cana where you blessed it with a miracle. For the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony. R
- 5. For healing us by forgiving our sins. For the Sacrament of Reconciliation and the Sacrament of the Sick. R
- 6. For delivering us from the oppression of evil. For the Rite of Exorcism and the Ministry of Deliverance. R
- 7. For helping us believe in the resurrection, by raising people from the dead. R
- 8. For the Transfiguration, revealing your divine nature as the only begotten Son of God. R
- 9. For teaching us how to clean and keep our temples holy places of worship. R
- 10. For giving us your Body and Blood in the bread and wine of the Last Supper. For the Sacrament of the Eucharist. **R**

Thank you for proclaiming the Kingdom of God on earth, and for the love, mercy, justice, communion and peace that you bestow upon us.

The Third Mystery of Salvation, the Passion and Death of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Our Father...

1. For the agony in the garden and your consent to be the sacrificial lamb of God, the atonement for our sins and those of the whole world. R: Have mercy on us and on the whole world (Longer version: Eternal Father, I offer you the body and blood, soul and divinity of your dearly beloved Son, our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

- 2. For being betrayed by one of your apostles and arrested by the Temple guards. R
- 3. For being unjustly tried by Pilate and condemned to death by the people you came to save. R
- 4. For being flogged at the pillar, mocked and beaten, made to wear a crown of thorns, and forced to carry your cross through the streets of your beloved city of Jerusalem. **R**
- 5. For Mary, your Mother, Veronica, and the women of Israel who wept at your side and offered you consolation. R
- 6. For falling under the weight of our sins and for Simon of Cyrene who helped carry your cross. R
- 7. For being stripped of your clothes and nailed to the cross. R
- 8. For giving us your Blessed Mother to watch over us and pray for us. R
- 9. For commending your spirit to our Heavenly Father and for your death on the cross. *Our Father...Hail Mary...Glory be...*
- 10. For descending into death and hell for the salvation of our souls. R

Thank you for your sorrowful passion, for the saving power of your death, and for the love, mercy, justice, communion and peace that you bestow upon us.

The Fourth Mystery of Salvation, the Resurrection and Ascension into Heaven of our Lord Jesus Christ. Our Father...

- 1. For announcing your Resurrection to Mary Magdalene in the tomb on the morning of the third day. **R:** We worship you O Lord. (Longer version: Hail Mary or Glory be...)
- 2. For the zeal of Peter and John who ran to search for you in the empty tomb. R
- 3. For revealing your Resurrection in the breaking of the bread to the disciples on the road the Emmaus. R
- 4. For appearing to your disciples who were hiding in fear behind locked doors. R
- 5. For helping Thomas believe by inviting him to see and touch your wounds. R
- 6. For appearing to over 500 chosen ones, eating and drinking with them as a sign of the resurrection of the body. **R**
- 7. For reconciling with Peter and declaring him the rock on which you will build your church. R
- 8. For sending forth your disciples to baptize all nations in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. **R**
- 9. For your glorious Ascension into heaven as you promised to be with us always. R
- 10. For the outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost to dwell in our hearts forever. R

Thank you for your Glorious Resurrection and Ascension into heaven, and for the love, mercy, justice, communion and peace that you bestow upon us.

The Fifth Mystery of Salvation, the Holy Catholic Church.

- 2. For St. Paul and all those who share the Good News through their personal witness and testimony. R

- 4. For the Assumption into heaven of the Blessed Virgin Mary. R (Hail Mary...)
- 5. For the Coronation of Mary, as Queen of heaven and earth. R
- 6 For Mary's perpetual prayers and presence in the life of the Church. R
- 7. For the Church Triumphant in heaven. **R** (**Glory be..**.)
- 8. For the Church Suffering in Purgatory. R
- 9. For the Church Militant on earth. R
- 10. For the Salvation of all souls. Our Father...Hail Mary...Glory be...
